Dr. Waleed Al-Qasrawi began his role as Assistant Director General of the Jordan Deposit Insurance Corporation (JODIC) in April 2025. He has an extensive experience in the banking sector, gained through his work at the Central Bank of Jordan. He held several positions, starting in 1990 in the Banking Supervision Department, then moving in 2013 to the Financial Stability Department, where he contributed to its establishment. At the end of 2016, he was tasked with founding the Financial Consumer Protection Department, applying international best practices to position it as one of the leading departments in the Arab region. In 2023, he transferred to the Money Exchange Supervision Department.

During his tenure at the Central Bank, he chaired several committees, most notably the head of Technical Committee of The King Abdullah II Award for Excellence in Government Performance and Transparency, where the Central Bank won first place among the top ministries and institutions participating in the award. He also chaired the Technical Committee for Crisis Management, which developed the Crisis Management Guide, praised by international entities such as the International Monetary Fund (IMF). Additionally, he contributed to preparing several key regulations and projects at the Central Bank, including the Basel III instructions.

his appointment as Assistant Director General comes as part of leveraging his broad expertise to assist in implementing the Financial Sector Assessment Program (FSAP) recommendations, establishing the regulatory framework and resolution procedures for banks, as well as establishing a supervisory activity within the Corporation.

He holds a PhD in Banking from Loughborough University (2009), a Master's degree in Banking from Bangor University (1999), and a Bachelor's degree in Accounting from Yarmouk University (1986).
