Dr. Jamal Mohammed Salah started his career at the Central Bank of Jordan (CBJ) where he held several positions at the Research Department between September 1970 and January 1983. After that, Dr. Salah moved to Qatar Central Bank and served as Economic Advisor to the Bank between January 1983 and February 1988.

In 1988, Dr. Salah rejoined the Central Bank of Jordan and held the position of the Assistant Executive Director of the Research Department from February 1988 to January 1993. Then, he was promoted to the position of Executive Director of the Department till April 1994.

In 1994, Dr. Salah was appointed as the Director General of Jordan Loan Guarantee Corporation. He remained in this position until November 1999 and held the same position during the period 1/6/2008-1/7/2011. He also served as the Secretary General of the Ministry of Planning during the period November 1999 - January 2001.

In 2001, Dr. Jamal Salah served as Advisor to the Prime Ministry, and then as Advisor to the Islamic Development Bank in Saudi Arabia in July 2001 and remained in the same position until 2007.

Currently, Dr. Salah is a member of the Board of Directors of Islamic Microfinance Company and a former member of several Boards of Directors: Jordan Petroleum Refinery Company representing Islamic Development Bank / Saudi Arabia during the period 2007 – 2015, and the Arab Potash Company representing Islamic Development Bank / Saudi Arabia during the period 2014-2017, and representing the Jordanian Government in various companies and entities during the period 1999-2001, such as: Jordan Telecommunication Company, Industrial Development Bank, Arab Planning Institute - Kuwait, Housing and Urban Development Corporation, Academic Research of the University of Jordan, Phosphate Company, Jordan Valley Authority, and Jordan Paper and Cardboard Factories Company during the period 1994-1998.

Dr. Jamal Salah received his PhD in Economics (Money and Banking) from Keele University in 1979, a master's degree in the same specialization and university in 1977, and a bachelor's degree in Economics and Statistics from the University of Jordan in 1970.
